One crisis follows the next and it's the same with wars. Rents, energy costs and food: everything is getting more and more expensive. However, this does not affect everyone equally. The rich are getting richer, while further people are becoming poor or are threatened by poverty.

The problem is called capitalism. The market does not regulate a fair supply of housing, health and sustainable climate policy, but primarily serves the profits of a few. Although the problems and injustice can no longer be overlooked, the SPD and Greens in Hamburg are not changing this. On the contrary: they continue to dismantle the welfare state.

This benefits not only corporations and shareholders, but also those on the right. More and more people are losing confidence in democracy because parties no longer represent their interests. The AfD is cooking up its brown soup on this political disenchantment and blame refugees, immigrants, the unemployed and climate protection, among others, for the current situation.

Preventing people from fleeing to Germany,

intensifying deportations, expelling immigrants, cancelling social benefits, tougher sanctions for benefit recipients and less climate protection do not solve a single problem. They only fuel fear and incitement against people and jeopardise social and democratic achievements.

We stand for a fundamentally different policy: we fight for the socialisation of all goods and services that are necessary for human existence: Housing and energy, health and care, mobility and climate protection, culture and education.

There is enough money. It just needs to be redistributed and used in the right places. Wealth tax must be reintroduced, crisis profits skimmed off and the debt brake abolished. Instead of investing 100 billion „special assets“ in arming the German armed forces, we need more funds for public welfare.

We cannot achieve all of our demands and political goals in the Hamburg-Nord district alone. In addition to the political will of the other parties and financial resources, there is also a lack of powers. We also want to change this and campaign for more decision-making powers for the districts and genuine participation by the people of Hamburg-Nord.

We not only demand more political participation, they are elementary components of our work. We want to fundamentally change the situation. To achieve this, we do not stop at speeches, motions and questions in parliament, but fight together with trade unions, social movements and all those who want to redistribute wealth and overcome poverty as well as for peace, social equality, international solidarity and against right-wing agitation.

# We stand for a radical change in policy:

- for **social justice**, with which we will also push back the AfD and other far-right organisations.
- for **combating the causes of flight**: Diplomacy instead of arms deliveries and combating exploitation and environmental destruction worldwide.
- in favour of a district in **which refugees, immigrants** and their descendants are welcome.
- for **affordable rents** by means of rent caps, expropriation and the creation of real social housing in existing buildings and on already sealed areas instead of at the expense of **green spaces** and **climate protection** such as the Diekmoor in Langenhorn and the Goldbekufer in Winterhude.
- for **better health** by fighting poverty and providing good medical care in all districts, as we have long been calling for with a district health centre in Dulsberg, for example.
- for the strengthening of **democracy and culture** through better participation and codetermination of all people and the promotion of neighbourhood culture.
- in favour of a „**school for all**“ that overcomes inequality and promotes learning for a humane society without a competitive mindset. This is another reason why the **Bundeswehr must be kept out** of schools!
- in favour of **equal rights** for all people, regardless of gender, sexual orientation, age, origin and nationality, religion and ideology, disability and social background.
- for **sustainable mobility** by improving and expanding footpaths and cycle paths as well as free bus and rail travel.
